4 Months	DTaP-IPV-Hib-HB Pneumococcal conjugate (PCV13) Meningococcal conjugate (Men C) Rotavirus (ROT-5)
6 Months	DTaP-IPV-Hib-HB Pneumococcal conjugate (PCV13)* (*for high risk children only) Rotavirus (ROT-5)
6 Months and older	Influenza ³
1 Year	MMRV ⁴ Pneumococcal conjugate (PCV13) Meningococcal conjugate (Men C)
18 Months	DTaP-IPV-Hib ⁵ MMRV
4 Years	dTap-IPV ⁶
Grade 6	HBV ⁷ (2-doses) HPV-9 ⁸ (2-doses)
Grade 9	dTap ⁹ MenC-ACYW-135 ¹⁰
